Dogs

The Township of Greater Madawaska's Animal Control By-law 09-2008 regulates the ownership and activity of dogs in the Municipality. Please take time to review the By-law, available on our website, as well as the Provincial legislation that regulates your dog.

For dogs at large, dog attacks and other dog related issues please contact Municipal Law Enforcement Services (MLES) at 613-281-3773.

Animal Control Services are for domestic animals only. Your dog is not to trespass even when on a leash!

Dog Licences

All residents must purchase an annual licence for their dogs. Licences expire on December 31 of each year. Landlords, please notify your tenants. Dog tags are sold at the Township Office at a discounted rate before the end of March. Tags can be mailed by request.




