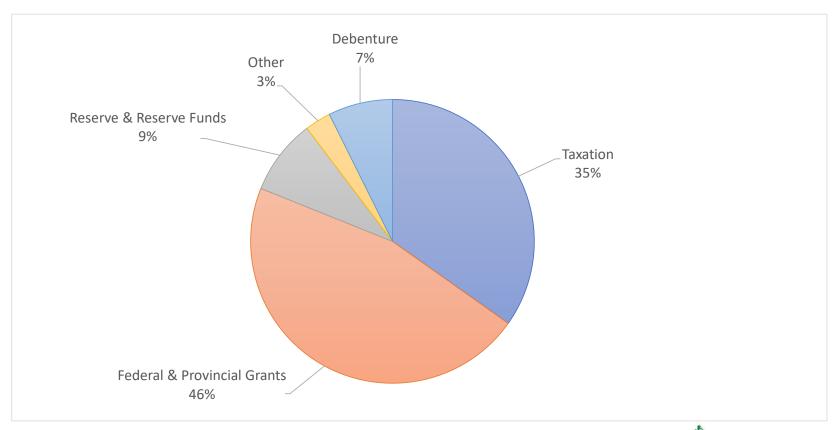

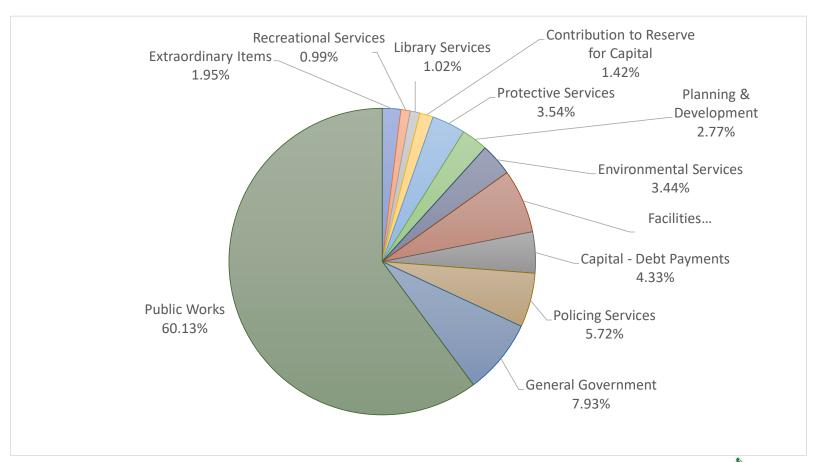

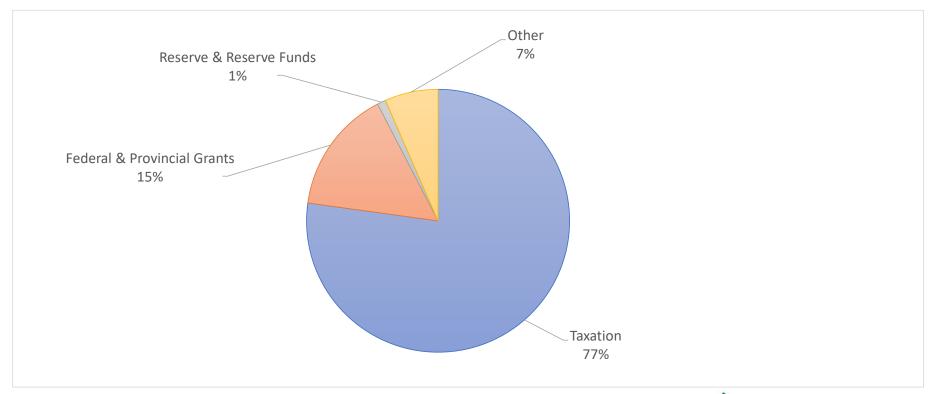

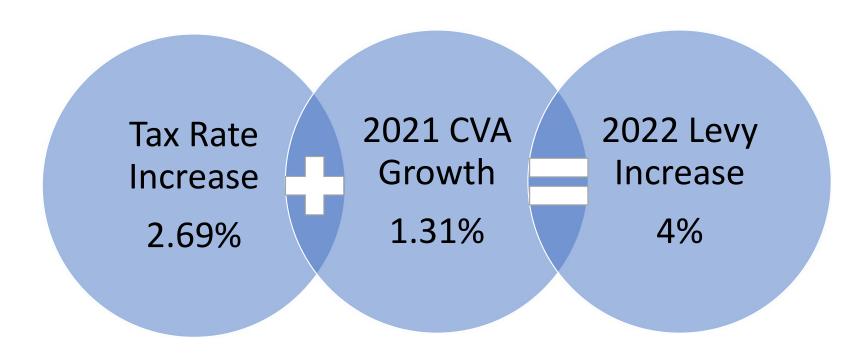

Property Taxation – Current Value Assessment

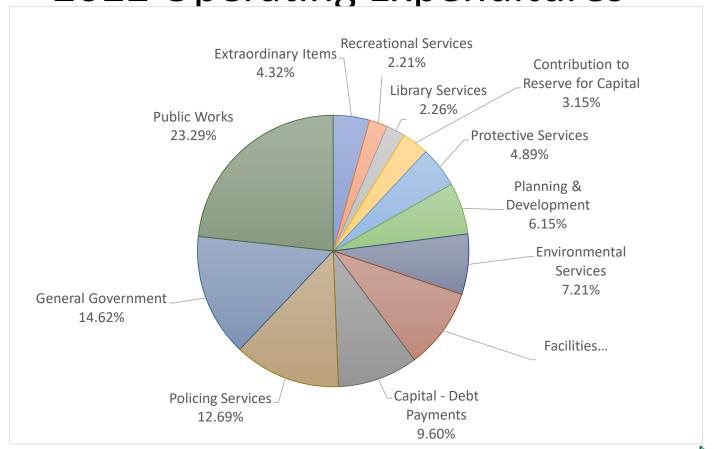


Property Taxation - Impact
