

Take Action on RADON Information Session

A recent study commissioned by Health Canada found that only **7% of Ontarians have tested their home for radon**, a radioactive gas that is the leading cause of lung cancer in non-smokers.

To counter this issue, *Take Action on Radon*, a coalition of national health organizations, is working with the Rural Municipality of Calabogie to distribute 100 free radon test kits this November as part of a broader initiative to raise awareness about the health risks associated with radon and to collect data on radon levels in the municipality.

Test kits will be distributed on Thursday, November 21st at 7 p.m.
