Financial Statement

- The Financial Statement received from Township Finance is missing key information; we are awaiting updates which we understand will come after the Audit is complete
- Re wages and benefits we are ahead approximately \$2,500 due to our lockdown restrictions. This will change when staff hours increase over the summer when we will 'catch-up' to the budget projection.
- Computer purchase expenses are showing in 2022 budget. We have an agreement with the Township to pay for the computers from a wage surplus we had from the 2021 budget. We anticipate this will be addressed by Finance and reflected going forward.
- Everything appears to be falling into line as anticipated and we should have the final audited results by our next meeting
