

The Matawatchan Hall was built in 1954 to honour returning soldiers. In 2017, with the help of an Ontario 150 Capital Program grant, the Township of Greater Madawaska, the Griffith & Matawatchan Fish & Game Club, the Bernie O'Connor Memorium, and Hall savings, the building was improved by winterizing it, which has saved the structure from deterioration.
