Ontario Drug Benefit (ODB) Program

If you are 65 and older and have a valid Ontario Health Card, you qualify for the ODB program. You will be sent a letter several months before you turn 65. You will be required to pay a deductible at the beginning of the ODB benefit year (August 1st). Once the deductible is paid, approved prescriptions will cost up to \$6.11.

If you are a senior with low income, you can apply for the Seniors Co-Payment Program to have the deductible waved and the co-payment reduced to \$2.00. Application kits are available at your local pharmacy, the website listed below, or by calling the application phone number. Wal-Mart and Chartrand's pharmacies both discount the co-payment by \$2.00 for all seniors.

An independent provincial tribunal, the Consent and Capacity Board's (CCB) mission is the fair and accessible adjudication of consent and capacity issues, balancing the rights of vulnerable individuals with public safety. The CCB's key areas of activity are the adjudication of matters of capacity, consent, civil committal and substitute decision making. Over 80 percent of applications to the CCB involve a review of a person's involuntary status in a psychiatric facility under the Mental Health Act, or a Review under the Health Care Consent Act of a person's capacity to consent to or refuse treatment.

Health Promotion and Clinical Services consist of public health nurses, health promoters, dental hygienists, home visitors, registered practical nurses and a community dietitian who work to protect and promote health, activities including immunization clinics, education related to prevention of chronic disease, prevention of falls, dental screening of children in schools, prenatal education, breastfeeding education, Healthy Babies Healthy Children Programs and Child Health Clinics.

Program Planning and Evaluation: local health statistics are analyzed to help understand the factors affecting the health of the community, and to ensure that public health programs address local population needs.
