TOWNSHIP OF GREATER MADAWASKA

By-Law No. 17 - 2002

BEING A BY-LAW TO PROHIBIT THE DRIVING OF MOTORIZED VEHICLES ALONG OR ACROSS ANY OR PART OF ANY TOWNSHIP PARKS AND PARK PROPERTY.

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. M.45, Section 207, subsection 42, authorizes the Council of a municipality to pass By-Laws prohibiting the vehicles and conveyances of every description and whatever the motive power or any particular kind or class of such vehicles or conveyance being upon or being used along or upon any pathway or footpath or other place set apart for public recreation

NOW THEREFORE the Council of Township of Greater Madawaska enacts as follows:

- 1. THAT "motorized vehicle" means a self-propelled vehicle of any kind.
- 2. **THAT** no person shall bring upon or use a motorized vehicle upon any Park or Playground within the Township of Greater Madawaska.
- 3. **THAT** every person who contravenes this By-Law is guilty of an offence and on conviction is liable to a fine of not more than \$500.00 exclusive of costs recoverable under the provisions of the Summary Convictions Act.
- 4. THAT this by-law shall come into full force and effect January 2, 2003.

READ a first and second time this 12th day of December, 2002.

READ A THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 12th DAY OF DECEMBER, 2002.
