- 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, that all By-Laws or parts thereof, and all or any resolutions of Council contrary thereto, or insistent herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed.

- 7. The Applicant shall be responsible for all utility permits and co-ordination of.
- 8. The Applicant shall strictly comply with all relevant legislation including Building Code Act, Occupational Health and Safety Act and Workplace Safety Insurance Act.
- 9. The Applicant shall assume any and all liability for any damage or injury sustained by the Township or any third party as a result of the work and shall save the Township harmless therefrom and fully indemnify the Township. The Township takes no responsibility for the utility / work undertaken by the applicant or the applicants agents.
- 10. Any other requirement as determined by the Township Roads Manager and CAO.
