

March 2024 Council Highlights

The **Marketing Implementation Plan,** created by Cinnamon Toast Inc. was presented and received by Council. Staff have been instructed to proceed with the rebranding recommendation. Details are contained in the <u>Plan</u> and the <u>Report to Council</u>.

Council awarded the contract for completing the technical reports and application required for **Black Donald Pit Expansion** to Jp2G Consultants Inc. The expansion of the pit was deemed essential for various reasons; one being the challenges in securing tenders for winter sand, the expansion will enable the on-site production of winter sand and crushed gravel, resulting in cost reductions.

A new **Pumper Tanker** will be purchased in 2025, to replace the aged 1989 Tanker. The process for purchasing needs to begin now in order to guarantee delivery in 2025.

As per the *Municipal Act, 2001* a **Statement of Remuneration and Expenses** incurred by members of Council must be provided annually. The statement was provided by the Treasurer and was approved by Council.

The decision was made to proceed with development of a system and by-law for the licencing of **Short-Term Accommodations** within the Township. The <u>Report of Findings</u> outlines the data, comments, and feedback received to this point. Next step to be taken is circulating the revised by-law for public feedback.

Council passed **Resolutions to show Support** of the following topics:

- Provincial Cemetery Management Support
- Revision of the definition of "Employer" in the Occupational Health and Safety Act
- Provincial Funding for the Municipal Equipment Operator Course

Council Held Closed Sessions, regarding the Causeway Easement and Smithson Lane.

Other Items from March 2024, Several construction and capital project tenders were awarded, Zoning By-Law Amendment 2306.5 was approved, Committee Policy was revised, Denbigh Griffith Lions Club Request for Funding was approved.
