Submission Instructions

1. Bidding System Registration

To obtain documents online please visit <https://greatermadawaska.bidsandtenders.ca> You can preview the bid documents with a Preview Watermark prior to registering for the opportunity. Documents are not provided in any other manner.

2. Submission of Tenders

Tenders must be submitted electronically through the bidding system at:

Submissions by other methods will not be accepted.

In the event of any technical issues, respondents should contact the bidding system's technical support.

3. Tenders to be Submitted on Time

Tenders must be finalized and fully uploaded in the bidding system on or before the Submission Deadline of February 22, 2024, at 1:00 p.m. The time of receipt of Tenders will be determined by the bidding system web clock. Late submissions will not be accepted by the bidding system and will be disqualified as late.

Respondents are cautioned that the timing of submission is based on when the tender is received by the bidding system, not when a tender is submitted by a respondent. As transmission can be delayed due to file transfer size, transmission speed, or other technical factors, respondents should plan to submit tenders well in advance of the submission deadline.

The bidding system will send a confirmation email to the respondent advising when the tender is submitted successfully. If you do not receive a confirmation email, contact the bidding system's technical support immediately.

4. Withdrawal of Tenders

Prior to the Submission Deadline, respondents may withdraw a submitted tender through the bidding system. To withdraw a tender after the Submission Deadline, a notice of

withdrawal must be sent to RFT Contact and must be signed by an authorized representative of the respondent.

5. Tender Acceptance

The selected respondent will be notified by email and/or telephone. The lowest or any tender may not necessarily be accepted.

Responsibilities of the Bidder

1. The Bidder hereby offers to furnish all machinery, tools, apparatus and materials.
2. The successful bidder shall provide a cheque to the Township of Greater Madawaska for 10% of the bid total within 48 hours of being awarded the bid. Failure to provide this cheque shall result in cancellation of the Contract.
3. The successful bidder shall provide a certified copy of the Firm's Public Liability and Property Damage Insurance Policy for the works. Coverage shall be at least \$5,000,000 per accident in the name of the Township. Failure to provide such proof shall result in cancellation of the Contract. The Liability Insurance Certificate and the proof of WSIB coverage must be submitted to the Township before any work may commence.

Information to Bidder

The Contractor shall abide, if applicable, by the requirements of the Industrial Standards Act, the Employment Standards Act and any other Acts or By-Laws which are relative to the performance of the work.

Completion

Specific completion dates shall be of the essence of this agreement. Failure to comply with specified completion dates may result in tender/contract cancellation, thereby utilizing the contractor's tender deposit for any and/or extra costs incurred by the Township of Greater Madawaska.

Damage by Vehicles and Other Equipment

If at any time, in the opinion of the Public Works Supervisor, damage is being done or is likely to be done to any highway or any improvement thereon by the Contractor's vehicles or other equipment whether licensed or unlicensed, the Contractor shall, on the direction of the Public Works Supervisor and at the Contractor's own expense make changes in or substitutions for such vehicles or

other equipment or shall alter loading or shall in some other manner remove the cause of such damage to the satisfaction of the Public Works Supervisor.

Loading of Motor Vehicles

Where a vehicle is hauling material for use on the work under the contract, in whole or in part upon a public highway and where motor vehicles registration is required for such vehicle, the Contractor shall not cause or permit such vehicle to be loaded beyond the legal limit as specified in the Highway Traffic Act, whether such vehicle is registered in the name of the Contractor or otherwise.

Material Testing

The Township staff and or Township engineer will be randomly sampling and testing the gradation of the material delivered on the road to ensure compliance.

If the material delivered does not comply with specifications, the Township may reduce payment by the percentage of material that does not meet the specification.

Measurement For Payment

Measurement for payment of surface treatment applied will be by the units of square meters and will include only those materials incorporated into the work and accepted by the Public Works Supervisor, **OR** by the tonne if hot mix asphalt is accepted.

Specifications/Tendering Requirements

The Contractor has carefully examined the provisions, plans, specifications and conditions attached to this tender and has carefully examined the site and location of the work to be done under this contract; and the Contractor also understands and accepts the said provisions, plans, specifications and conditions and for the prices set forth in this tender, hereby offers to furnish all machinery, tools, apparatus and other means of construction, furnish all materials, except as otherwise specified in the contract and to complete the work in strict accordance with the provisions, plans, specifications and conditions attached to this tender. All bids must be received in sealed envelopes.

It is agreed that the tender quantities are estimated only and may be increased or decreased by the Township without alteration of the contract price. However, should such an increase or decrease exceed 20%, then either party to the contract may request, in writing, that negotiations be carried out to determine if a revised unit price would be appropriate.

Double Surface Treatment consisting of HF-150 P (Polymer) emulsion and 5/8" aggregate for the first lift plus HF-150 P and 3/8" stone chips for the top lift.

⇒ HF-150 P (Polymer) Double Application Rate = 3.2 litres per square metre.

⇒ HF-150 P (Polymer) emulsion are to conform to OPSS 1103.

⇒ All aggregates are to conform to OPSS 304.

⇒ First lift aggregate application rate = 19.3 kg/m²

⇒ Top lift aggregate application rate = 17.1 kg/m²
