Online Property Tax Accounts

Great News!

In June, we launched our new **Online Financial Services Portal**. This service allows residents to view their **property tax account** activity and to receive tax bills via email or through the portal.

Registration is simple by following the step-by-step instructions available on the Portal. You will require your Roll Number and PIN to register, which can be found on your latest property tax bill. Reach out to the Finance Department with any questions or for help registering.

Short-Term Accommodation License Required

As per By-Law 16-2024, a license is required for all Short Term Accommodations operating in the Township of Greater Madawaska. As of August 1, 2025 a monetary fine can be imposed on any STA Owner not holding a valid license. Refer to the Township website for details on how to apply.
